Dr. Manley is an Evansville native and graduate of Central High School. He graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1974 and served in the nuclear submarine force for nine years. His assignments included tours of duty in the engineering department of *USS Seawolf* (SSN 575) and as Navigator/Operations Officer in *USS Plunger* (SSN 595). Some of the exploits of *Seawolf* when he was aboard are chronicled in the books *Blind Man's Bluff* and *Red November*.

Dr. Manley left active duty in the Navy in 1983 to attend Indiana University School of Medicine, graduating in 1987. He completed a family practice residency at Deaconess Hospital in Evansville in 1990. He became board certified in family medicine in 1990 and recertified in 1996, 2002 and 2008.

His first medical position was as a full-time emergency physician at St. Mary's Warrick Hospital where he worked for one year. He then joined Deaconess Family Medical Center in Newburgh and worked there for four years. In 1995, Dr. Manley closed his medical practice to attend Indiana University School of Law in Bloomington. He graduated cum laude in 1997 and passed his bar examination on his first attempt.

In 1997, Dr. Manley rejoined the staff at Warrick Hospital as an ER doctor. A year later he joined Mission Health Medical Group in Newburgh where he worked for four years as a family physician. In 2002, he and his staff left Mission Health to enter solo private practice.

In November 2002, Plaza Park Family Practice and Déjà Vu Skin & Vein Center opened in Newburgh. PPF is a full-service family practice. Déjà Vu offers state of the art laser and medical skin care. Déjà Vu is also the most comprehensive vein treatment facility in the Tri-State area. Dr. Manley achieved board certification in Phlebology (specialist in vein disease) in 2009. He is the only board-certified vein specialist within 100 miles of Evansville.

Information About Some of Our Services

These are just a sampling of our services. In general, whatever your medical problem, start with your family doctor. If we cannot take care of your problem, we will promptly refer you to the appropriate specialist.



Accidents/Injuries: We take care of all non-life-threatening emergencies, including cuts, burns, sprains, and falls.

Allergy Testing: We perform complete allergy skin testing and perform allergy shots.

Attention Deficit Disorder & Depression: We will evaluate your child's case and recommend counseling, medication, or both, as appropriate. We also diagnose and treat adult ADD.

Back or Neck Pain Injections: We provide ultrasound-guided cortisone injections of the lower back or neck.

Blood Tests: We can draw virtually any required blood test.

Cardiac Stress Testing: We perform exercise echocardiographic stress testing as well as dobutamine stress testing.

Gynecology and Routine Female Examinations: We provide a full range of gynecological services including routine Pap smears; breast exams; endometrial biopsies; colposcopy (evaluation of abnormal Pap smears); birth control; IUD insertion; and treatment for menopause, PMS, and painful or irregular periods.

Headaches: We care for migraine, muscle tension, and other types of headaches.

Immunizations: All adults (based on age and risk factors) should be vaccinated.

IV Therapy: Our skilled registered nurses start and administer IV's. Many sick or dehydrated patients may be treated.

Newborn and Well Child Care: We care for children of all ages and provide all preventative care services and immunizations.

Orthopedics: We provide a broad range of orthopedic care including injections of the shoulder, knee, carpal tunnel, trigger finger, elbow, hip (for bursitis), and many other areas.

Pain Management: We have many chronic patients and we stay current on the latest pain treatments including nerve blocks, trigger point injections, electro-acupuncture and drug treatments. We also use ultrasound-guided cortisone injections when appropriate.

Ultrasound Testing: We have complete ultrasound and echocardiography services of the same quality available at hospitals or diagnostic centers. Our tests are performed by board-certified sonographers and read by cardiologists and radiologists.

Weight Loss: Obesity is a fatal disease. We can individualize a plan of diet, exercise, and medication (if appropriate) to help you lose weight. Weight loss should be part of a total plan of care supervised by your family doctor.

Acne Treatment: This is a serious, disfiguring disease and we treat it aggressively with all therapies including chemical peels, microdermabrasion, lasers, prescription medications, and, when needed, Accutane®.

Rosacea Treatment: We offer the most advanced rosacea treatment available including laser/intense pulsed light therapy.

Skincare: Déjà Vu Skin & Vein Center is a part of our practice. We offer a wide variety of advanced skincare procedures. We also evaluate and, if necessary, take off almost all types of skin lesions, including moles, cysts, and skin tags. We also perform skin cancer screening and remove most skin cancers.

Varicose Vein Treatment: We offer advanced varicose vein treatment for all types of venous disease—from large protruding varicosities to tiny spider veins. We are the only facility in the area to offer all of the latest modalities of varicose vein treatments.
